# **INSTRUCTOR/GUARD**

**(Part-time - Open Competitive)**

### **SALARY**

### **THE POSITION**

Instructs swimming to all ages; supervises swimmers at public swim times; cleans and supervises locker rooms; renders first aid as needed; enforces policies, rules and regulations of the pool; ensures patron safety; helps maintain pool equipment in safe working condition; assists with pool clean-up; performs other duties as assigned.

### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS**

Must be at least 17 years of age; possess current Red Cross First-Aid, CPR, Lifeguard Training as well as Water Safety Instructor certificates.

### **SELECTION PROCESS**

The selection process may consist of the following phases:

Application Screening  
Oral Interview  
Practical and/or Written Exam

### **FILING PROCESS**

### **FINAL FILING**

The El Monte Aquatic Center is now recruiting for Instructor/Guards for the 2009 summer season. Interested candidates must complete an application and pass a swim test. The swim test will consist of a 500 yd. Swim in less than 9 minutes and 30 seconds, tread water for one minute using legs only and two rescue scenarios. Candidates must pass the Swim Test to reach the interview phase. The Swim test will be held on Saturday, May 16 at 9:00 A.M. at the El Monte Aquatic Center.

There will be two dates for interviews for this classification. The first date will be Wednesday, May 20. The second interview date will be Thursday, May 21.

**The last date to submit an application will be Tuesday, May 12, 2009.**
